

Four in a Row Multiplication

What you need:

2 players, 1 game board, 18 counters for player 1 and 18 counters in a different colour for player 2, 2 paper clips

Rules:

- Player 1 starts by putting the paper clips on any two numbers in the row at the base of the board.
- Player 1 multiplies these two numbers and covers that answer on the board with a counter of their chosen colour. (eg paper clips placed on 6 and 5 - place a counter on 30)
- Player 2 then moves only one paper clip to a new number in the row at the base of the board.
- Player 2 multiplies the paper clip numbers together and covers that answer on the board with one of their counters
- Play continues like this moving one paper clip at a time
- If the answer to multiplying two paper clip numbers is already covered the player misses that turn.
- The winner is the first player to have four of their counters in a row vertically, horizontally, or diagonally.
