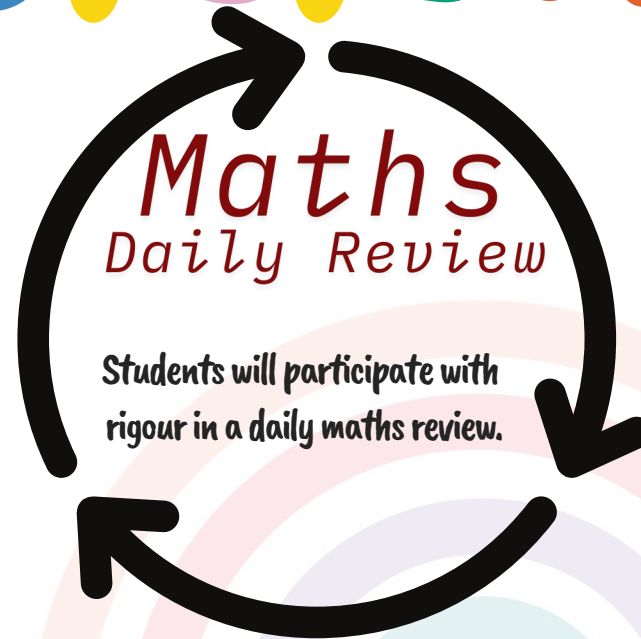




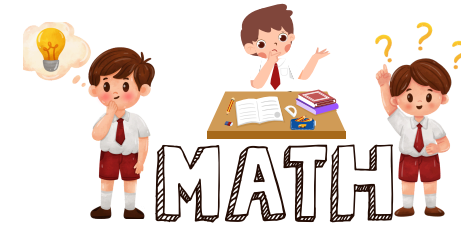

Students will participate with rigour in a daily maths review.

Students

Engage in the maths daily review with rigour

SSOs

Differentiate the learning if required
Allowing students to 'struggle' a little longer
Encourage students to think through problem solving, not solve it for them (ask 'How can you solve that problem?')

Teachers:

Develop a daily math review based on the SA Mathematics Curriculum.
Use a daily review (with fidelity) in the classroom a minimum 4 days a week.

Leaders

Share information about maths with Governing Council and parents via newsletters and meetings.
Establish maths non-negotiables - Daily math review in all classes by the end of 2025.
